## **PFIZER**

16 years and older

2 doses, 21 days apart

Injection site pain, fatigue, headache, muscle pain, joint pain, and fever

## **MODERNA**

18 years and older

2 doses, 28 days apart and older

Injection site pain, fatigue, headache, muscle pain, joint pain, and fever JOHNSON & JOHNSON

18 years and older

1 dose

Injection site reactions, headache, fatigue, myalgia, nausea, and fever

According to clinical trial data, all 3 authorized vaccines are 100% effective at preventing hospitalization and death related to COVID-19.

Side effects are normal and are a sign that your body is developing immunity against the virus that causes COVID-19. They should go away within a day or two. Not everyone will experience side effects.

If you have chronic health conditions you can still get this vaccine. You are more at risk of having complications from COVID-19 if you get infected with the virus.

Women who are pregnant, breastfeeding or are trying to become pregnant are also advised to receive the vaccine. Getting infected with COVID-19 while pregnant can cause medical complications to the mother and baby. Please talk to your doctor about getting the vaccine if you have more questions.
